

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PONCHATOULA TRANSIT BUS SCHEDULE CHANGES

The City of Ponchatoula, in association with the Tangipahoa Voluntary Council on Aging and Tangipahoa Parish Government, are proposing to change the Ponchatoula transit bus route and time scheduling in order to make the system more efficient and more available to the public. Before finalizing any changes, the City invites the public to comment or ask questions about the proposed changes, times, and locations of stops, as shown in the posted schedule. The proposed bus schedule is posted on the front entry at Ponchatoula City Hall, at 125 W. Hickory Street in Ponchatoula and also on the Tangipahoa Parish Government website (www.tangipahoa.org), Public transit link. The City and Council on Aging will receive public comments for a minimum 10 day period following the date of this notice; public comment period will end on July 5th at 4 p.m. After such period, the public will be notified of the amended transit bus schedules.
